## Lent Begins February 25th

The Liturgical season of Lent is the 40 days (not including Sundays) leading up to Easter. Because the actual date for Easter shifts from year to year (it is the first Sunday following the first full moon following the Spring Equinox), the dates for Lent also fluctuate. This year it begins on February 25th. The color for the season is purple. Traditionally it has been a time to focus on themes of sacrifice and prayer. The season ends with Holy Week, including Palm/Passion Sunday, Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. This year you might consider doing something extra during the six weeks of Lent to enhance your spiritual journey. It need not be the traditional “giving up something for Lent.” Perhaps you could commit yourself to take on an extra project to help someone else. Or maybe you could try praying for 15 minutes every day. Be creative. Find something to remind yourself of God’s presence in your life and in the world. And be sure to join us for worship.


## New Tables & Chairs






**Stewardship Education & Commitment Emphasis Begins March 7th**
